NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of mone aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, on the west side of Whitney Street (formerly known as Hoover) in the village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., at Slater, S. C. and known and designated as Lot No. 1 of Block "C" on plat of the village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineers, in July, 1940 which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at pages 63, 64 and 65, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwest corner of the intersection of Whitney Street and Edison Street, and running thence with the North side of Edison Street, S. 87-32 W. 124.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot 37, N. 2-28 W. 75 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 2; thence with line of said lot, N. 87-32 E. 124.85 feet to an iron pin on Whitney Street; thence with the west side of Whitney Street, S. 2-26 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same property conveyed to me by J. S. Ward by deed dated April 24, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 290, at page 224.

Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineers, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at pages 63, 64 and 65, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Mellon Street, joint front corner of Lots No. 22 and 23 of Block H, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 22, N. 75-29 E. 117.8 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 27 of Block H; thence with the line of Lot No. 27, S. 28-32 E. 54.8 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 27, joint rear corner of Lots No. 23 and 24; thence with the line of Lot No. 24, S. 61-00 W. 124.9 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Mellon Street; thence with Mellon Street, N. 21-22 W. 85 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing,
