"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southern side of Mills Avenue Extension, near its intersection with Chapman Road, and being shown as a portion of 2.32 acres according to a plat of property formerly owned by J. P. Stevens & Co. located at Dunean Mills, said plat being prepared by Pickell and Pickell, June 23, 1953, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Mills Avenue Extension, which pin is 251.8 feet west of the intersection of Mills Avenue Extension and a 15-foot alley, and running thence along Mills Avenue Extension, S. 71-10 W. 75 feet to a point; thence S. 19-30 E. 122 feet, more or less, to a point; thence N. 25-16 E. 38 feet, more or less, to an old angle iron; thence along the line of property now or formerly belonging to Duke Power Company, S. 60-38 E. 72 feet, more or less, to a point; thence N. 19-30 W 147 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.

"The above described property is a portion of the same conveyed to me by C. J. Pride by deed dated May 3, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 500, at page 57."
