WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Nine Thousand, Two Hundred, Fifty and No/100 - - - -

(\$ 9.250.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate specified in said note, to be repaid in installments of

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the western side of McNeill Court, being known and designated as Lot No. 8 according to a plat of Wilton Oaks as made by Dalton & Neves in June of 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB, at page 49, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of McNeill Court, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 81-05 W. 125.2 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence N. 9-00 E. 50.3 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Ashley Avenue; thence along the Southern side of Ashley Avenue, N. 87-40 E. 97.7 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Ashley Avenue and McNeill Court; thence following the curvature of said intersection, the chord of which is S. 41-34 E. 38.1 feet to an iron pin on the western side of McNeill Court; thence along the western side of McNeill Court, S. 8-55 W. 45 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same conveyed to me by Edward C. McNeill by deed dated February 8, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 493, at page 502."
