C., on April 5, 1949, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at page 175. According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 21 Henry Street (Avenue) and fronts thereon 55 feet; being the same property conveyed to us by J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc. by deed dated June 1, 1949 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, Vol. 384, page 477.
