"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, on the Southeast corner of the intersection of the Augusta Road and Twin Springs Drive, being known and designated as Lot No. 101 of a subdivision known as Pecan Terrace as shown on Plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG", page 9, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at said intersection of the Augusta Road and Twin Springs Drive, and running thence with the Augusta Road, S. 14-12 W. 120 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 100; thence with the line of that lot, S. 75-48 E. 90 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 102; thence with the line of that lot, N. 70-22 E.78.2 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Twin Springs Drive; thence with seid Drive, the following courses and distances: N. 30-22 W. 64.5 feet to an iron pin at bend; thence N. 44-12 W. 58.5 feet to an iron pin at bend; thence N. 75-48 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
