All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, on the Eastern side of Cothram Street, being shown as the rear portion of Lots Nos. 75 and 76 on plat of property of G. J. Douglas Estate, recorded in Plat Book F, at page 126, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds. as follows:
