C. Milford, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at pages 121 and 122, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

''BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Sullivan street at the corner of Lot No. 17, and running thence along the north side of said Sullivan Street, S. 88-30 E. 35 feet to an iron pin at the corner of lot marked "sold"; thence along the line of that lot, N. 4-15 E. 184 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence N. 79-05 W. 9.7 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 12; thence along the rear line of said Lot No. 12, S. 18-36 W. 8 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said Lot No. 12; thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 13, 14 and 15, S. 15-16 W. 84 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the line of Lot No. 15, in a southwesterly direction 9.5 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 17; thence along the line of said Lot No. 17, S. 3-55 W. 91 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
