"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, All that lot of land in Greenville Township, on the Western side of Ladson Street, known as 102 Ladson Street, and designated as lot No. 2 on plat of property of Parrish and Gower, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in April, 1922, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County in Plat Book F at Page 49, which is incorporated into and made a part of this description, and according to said plat is described as follows:
