Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina: in Gantt Township on the northwest corner of the intersection of Mayflower Avenue and Pecan Drive being Lot No. 37 in a subdivision known as Pecan Terrace, Plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG", page 9 and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Pecan Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 36 and 37 and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 40-27 E. 109.8 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 19; thence with the line of that lot S. 39-26 E. 110.6 feet to an iron pin on the west side of Mayflower Avenue; thence with said Avenue S. 36-23 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence a circular line at the street intersection, the chord of which is S. 82 W. 35 feet to an iron pin on Pecan Drive; thence with said Drive N. 52-22 W. 90 feet to the beginning corner.
