NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, School District 160, formerly 6-E, being known and designated as Lot No. 7 of a revised plat of the property of W. R. Cordell made by Dalton & Neves, March, 1952, recorded in Plat Book Z, at page 44, said lot being a portion of a resubdivision of Lot No. 129, of Map 4, of a subdivision known as Camilla Park as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 117, and having, according to the Dalton revised plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of a 100-foot right-of-way for a Duke Power Company transmission line at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7, which pin is 220 feet South of the Old Easley Bridge Road, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots 6 and 7, N. 87-51 E. 183.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 21-0 E. 35.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 9-30 W. 37.1 feet to ah iron pin; thence S. 87-51 W. 187.5 feet to an iron pin on the East side of said transmission line right-of-way; thence along the East side of said right-of-way, N. 2-09 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
