To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

SEND GREETINGS:

(\$ 9,600.00 ) Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note,

(the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference) to be repaid in installments of Ninety-Six and No/100 - - - - - - - - - -

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described preperty, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Gantt Township, on the western side of Conley Street and the southern side of Sanford Court, known and designated as Lot No. 17 of a subdivision known as Belmont Heights as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at pages 54 and 55, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a pin on the western side of Conley Street at the common front corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 17 and running thence with the western side of Conley Street, S. 24-43 E. 160 feet to a pin at the corner of the intersection of Conley Street and Sanford Court; thence with the southern side of Sanford Court, S. 62-27 W. 125 feet to a pin at the common corner of Lots Nos. 16 and 17; thence with the line of Lot No. 16, N. 25-05 W. 166.6 feet to a pin on the line of Lot No. 15; thence with the line of Lot No. 15, N. 65-17 E. 126 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by William Wallace Hopkins by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
