G. C. Gibson, his heirs and assigns, all that tract or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. Being known and designated as Tracts Nos. 2, 3 and 4 as shown on plat of a subdivision known as Lowndes Hill Orchard, said plat being by W. O. Neves, dated November 25, 1916, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book "E", page 13, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
