"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southwestern corner of Douglas and Looper Streets near the City of Greenville, being Lots 97 and 98 on the plat of property of Eliza T. Looper from a plat fecorded in Plat Book "H" at Pages 159-160, and according to a survey made by J. C. Hill, January 7, 1956, described as follows:
