

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the state of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southeastern side of Old Rutherford Road containing 2.68 acres as shown on plat of the Estate of William S. Edwards, made by Dalton & Neves February, 1954, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Old Rutherford Road at the joint corner of tracts containing 25 acres and 2.68 acres, and running thence with the Old Rutherford Road S. 60-0 W. 234 feet to pin; thence S. 7-30 E. 151.8 feet to pin; thence S. 53-30 W. 165 feet to pin; thence S. 87-41 E. 513.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 67-35 E. 63.7 feet to pin in line of 25 acres tract; thence with the line of said tract N. 35-30 W. 445.5 feet to the point of beginning.
