BEGINNING at a stone on the Augusta Road and running thence S. 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 20.90 to a stone in the road bed; thence N. 33 3/4 E. 36.00 to a stone; thence N. 1 1/3 W. 17.00 to a hickory; thence N. 88- $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 10.95 to a stone; thence S. 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 43.38 to the beginning.
