

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said First National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, as Trustee under the Will of J. T. Jones, its successors and assigns: all that tract or lot of land in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. on the Southeast side of U. S. Highway 29, with improvements thereon, being known as 400 Wade Hampton Boulevard, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southeast side of U. S. Highway 29 on the Northeast intersection of said U. S. Highway 29 and Dupont Drive and running thence with Dupont Drive, S. 56-16 E. 137 feet to a point; thence S. 67-31 E. 83 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 22-29 E. 146 feet to an iron pin on a branch; thence with said branch as the line N. 81-46 W. 164.2 feet, more or less, to a point on the right of way of said U. S. Highway 29; thence with the said right of way, S. 46-45 W. 70 feet to a point; thence N. 43-29 W. 20 feet to a point; thence S. 46-31 W. 24.3 feet to the point of beginning.
