

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

(\$7.700.00 -) Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note, (the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference) to be repaid in installments of

upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, on the eastern side of Oakdale Street, being known and designated as Lot No. 8, Block A of Hughes Heights Subdivision, and being as shown on a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at Pages 122 and 123, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

*BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Oakdale Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8, Section A, and running thence along the common line of said Lots, S. 66-33 E. 153.1 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 11, Block A, S. 39-42 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 9, Block A, N. 58-59 W. 123 feet to an iron pin on Oakdale Street; thence along the eastern side of Oakdale Street, N. 21-02 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by Jennie B. Hughes (life tenant), T. T. Hughes, individually and as Executor & Trustee, and Fannie G. Hordon, individually and as Executrix and Trustee of the Estate of T. T. Hughes by deed dated March 28, 1956, not yet recorded."
