MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Vedder B. Watson and Leona V. Watson, of Greenville County,

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Eight Thousand. Nine Hundred and No/100 - - -

(\$ 8,900.00) Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note,

(the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference) to be repaid in installments of

Sixty-Seven and 48/100 - - - - - - upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAV-White SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt gain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or let of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Paris Mountain Township, being known and designated as all of Lot No. 22 and a triangular strip of Lot No. 21 of a subdivision known as Mauldin Meadows as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE, at page 151, and having, according to a revision of said plat made by C. C. Jones & Associates, Engineers, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of Mauldin Circle at the corner of Lot No. 23, and running thence along the line of that lot, S. 40-45 W. 154.4 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot in the line of Lot No. 24; thence along the line of Lot No. 24, N. 63-45 W. 40.9 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 20; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 20, N. 6-17 W. 55.4 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 21; thence on a line across Lot No. 21, N. 31-49 E. 128.7 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of Mauldin Circle, which point is 20 feet northwest of the corner of Lot No. 22; thence along the southwest side of Mauldin Circle, S. 49-15 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to us by J. H. Mauldin by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."

The last payment on this mortgage, if not sooner paid, will become due and payable 18 years after date.
