All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina in Oaklawn Township, and being a portion of Lot #20 conveyed to Grady Lollis by J.R. Ricketts by deed recorded in Deed Book 257 at page 298, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and more particularly described as follows:
