in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Carl B. Holland, his heirs and assigns forever:

Sanders, plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at page 149, said lot being located on the northern side of Arlington Road and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
