Whereas, the party of the second part	in consideration	of the uses	and purposes to which
said premises are devoted, as herein declared,			
in the amount offifteen Hundred	(\$1500.0)	•	Dollars,
to be secured and repaid as hereinafter set out:			

Row, the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the foregoing, for themselves and successors in office as Trustees, hereby promise and agree to and with the said party of the second part that in case the property hereinafter described shall ever hereafter be alienated from the Methodist Church, or cease to be used for or be devoted to other uses than the uses and purposes set forth herein, then the said parties of the first part shall and will forthwith repay to the party of the second part said amount, with lawful interest thereon, from the date of the aforesaid alienation, dissolution or abandonment.
