"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenvilla, Oneal Township, on the East side of State Highway No. 14, about five miles northward from Greer, being a portion of the Berry Place and designated as Tract No. 3 on a plat of the Bradburn Property by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated November 25, 1946, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a point in the center of State Highway No. 14 at the intersection of the said community road and on the WW. Bruce line, and runs thence with said community road N. 29-00 E. 200 feet to a bend; thence N. 38-30 E. 100 feet to a bend; thence N. 56-50 E. 200 feet to a bend; thence N. 63-55 E. 837 feet to a point on the J.C. Berry Estate line; thence with said line N. 19-30 W. 636 feet to an iron pin, J.C. Berry Estate corner; thence S. 73-00 W. 906 feet to a Red Oak corner; thence with the W.W.
