MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

The Evangelical Lutheran Church of Our Saviour, an eleemosynary corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Thirteen Thousand and No/100 - - - - - - - -

(\$\frac{13,000.00}{13,000.00})\$ Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note,

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, on the Northwestern side of Mable Avenue, being shown as Lot #31 on Plat #2 of the property of James M. Edwards in May 1953, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at page 60, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Mable Avenue, joint front corner of Lots #31 and 32, and running thence with the line of Lot #32, N. 47-08 W. 200 feet to an iron pin in rear line of Lot #21; thence with the rear lines of Lots #21 and 22, N. 42-52 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of Lot #30; thence with line of Lot #30, S. 47-08 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on Mable Avenue; thence with the northwestern side of Mable Avenue, S. 42-52 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by Dan H. McKinney by deed dated August 6, 1956 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 559, at page 329."

The loan evidenced by this mortgage is for the purpose of erecting a parsonage upon the above described property, and was authorized by unanimous vote of the congregation of The Evangelical Lutheran Church of Our Saviour at a regularly called meeting of said congregation on September 23, 1956. The construction of said parsonage was authorized by action of the congregation at a regularly called special meeting thereof held on July 15, 1956.

The corporation's charter was issued by the Secretary of State on September 17, 1956, and is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 562, at page 114.
