Columbia as described in the aforesaid security instrument shall, in all respects, except as to the premises hereinbefore described, be preserved and protected and that the lien of said security instrument, except as hereby released and discharged, shall remain in full force and effect and the terms, conditions and covenants thereof and of the note thereby secured, shall remain unchanged.
