All that certain lot our parcel or land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, St ate of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 18 on plat of property of C. E. Briscoe made by C. M. Furman, Jr., engineer, in May 1923 which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at page 166, which lot is more particularly described as follows:
