"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the western side of Broughton Drive in a subdivision known as Croftstone Acres, being known and designated as Lot No. 11, Block "G", of said subdivision and being designated according to a plat of Croftstone Acres recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "S", at pages 78 and 79 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
