ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the West side of a surface treated road leading South from the Scuffletown Road (sometimes referred to as the Woodruff Road) about five miles Southeast of the Greenville County Court House, in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 18.48 acres and being shown as the greater portion of Tract No. 5 on Plat of property of J. W. Norwood, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, March 6, 1936, inthe R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "I", Page 54 (see also Plat Book "K", page 139 and 140) and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:
