in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers Bank, its successors and assigns forever.

All that lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a portion of the Ida Burdette lands and consisting of the eastern portion of that tract as shown on a plat made by J. Mac Richardson, registered land surveyor in November, 1944. This plat is recorded in the office of the R.M.C., Greenville County Book Q at page 117.
