All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located about three miles North of Travelers Rest, S.C. on the Eastern side of U. S. Highway No. 276(Travelers Rest - Ceasers Head Road), the same being shown and designated as Lot No. 66 on a plat of property of the Nannie K. Hunt Estate, plat made by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated November 15 & 16, 1951, and recorded in Plat Book AA at page 134 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
