in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said WACO F. CHILDERS, Jr., and Glynn A. Lindsey, their heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 13, as shown on plat of Property of Morningside, as made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in December 1952, which plat is of record in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book "EE", at pages 2 and 3, and Plat Book "FF", at pages 84 and 85, reference to which plat is hereby made, said lot of land being described by metes and bounds, as follows, to-wit:
