NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, lying east from Blackberry Road and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stone and branch corner of property now or formerly owned by W. L. Farrell and running thence S. 80-30 W. an estimated 206 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in a road at corner of property this day conveyed to Otis and Cora Lee Fowler and running thence with said road S. 27-30 W. 176.7 feet to a stake thence N. 70-30 W. 166 feet to a stake; thence N. 5-30 E. 62.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 80-30 W. an estimated 105 feet, more or less, to steel pin; thence S. 31 W. 1171.3 feet to a stone in Dovers line; thence S. 58-00 E. 250.5 feet to a stake in branch; thence with the branch as the line in a northerly direction 1621.5 feet to the beginning corner."
