with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$50.00 on June 28, 1957, and a like payment of \$50.00 on the 28th dayof each month thereafter until paid in full, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal, with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per cent, per annum, to be computed semi-annually and paid monthly

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Grove Township, on the Western side of U.S. Highway # 29, and according to survey made by J. D. Calmes, on May 22, 1957, is described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a point in U.S. Highway # 29, the original corner of the property of Radie D. Cothran, at the corner of property now or formerly owned by Lena E. Garrett, and running thence with the line of the property of Lena E. Garrett, passing an iron pin on the right-of-way of said Highway, S. 79-25 E. 365 feet to an iron pin, the original corner of said Radie D.
