WITNESSETH:

AND WHEREAS it is mutually agreed that the security of this mortgage shall extend to and cover any additional loan made by the mortgagee, at its option, to said mortgagor or any of his successors in ownership of the real estate hereby conveyed; provided, that the total indebtedness to be secured hereby shall not exceed the original face amount of this mortgage and, provided further, that the maturity of such additional debt shall not be later than the time specified for the payment of the original debt secured hereby. This paragraph shall not however, in any way restrict advancements for taxes and insurance premiums provided for elsewhere in this mortgage. It is further mutually agreed that upon breach of any warranty against encumbrances contained in any application for an additional loan the mortgagee may declare all notes secured hereby immediately due and payable and may foreclose this mortgage.

NOW, THEREFORE, the mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to him in hand paid by the mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of this mortgage, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, by these presents hereby bargains, sells, grants and releases unto the said SHENANDOAH LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the northwest side of Marion Road, near Monoghan Mill, Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as Lot No. 50, as shown on a plat entitled "Monoghan Subdivision, Greenville, S. C." made by Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville, S. C., August 9, 1944; said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, pages 86 and 87, and having according to a recent survey made by T. C. Adams, Engineer, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Marion Road, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 50 and 51, the point of beginning being 170 feet to Cottingham Street, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 51, N. 48-04 W. 174.7 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 56; the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 50 and 51; thence with the line of Lots Nos. 56 and 57, N. 54-50 E. 76.9 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 49 and 50; thence with the line of Lot No. 49, S. 48-04 E. 157.5 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Marion Road, and the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 49 and 50; thence with the said Marion Road, S. 41-56 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner.
