E. Flynn, recorded in Plat Book G at page 92, and adjoining tract, and when described as a whole has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of Greenville-Taylors Highway, at corner of property now or formerly owned by B. F.
