Tennis Smith and on the west by said county road, containing 2.73

acres, more or less, being a part of that property conveyed to W. Dennis Smith by L.R. Wood, et al., by deed dated May 28, 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 435, page 514, and having the following courses and distances:
