EXTENSION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 1st day of November, 1957, between the Carolina Federal Savings & Loan Association of Greenville, South Carolina, a corporation, chartered under the laws of the United States, hereinafter called "CAROLINA", and Gregory Day Shorey, Jr., hereinafter called "OBLIGOR",

WITNESSETH:

March 10, 1955, executed by Charles E. Cooper and Pauline J. Cooper and delivered to Carolina in the original principal amount of \$20,000.00, and secured by mortgage upon the premises situate on the Northern side of Crescent Avenue, being known and designated as Units 40 and 41 of Block C, Forest Hills Subdivision in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described in the aforesaid mortgage which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 629 at page 479; and

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Gregory Day Shorey, Jr. by deed from CharlesE. Cooper and Pauline J. Cooper, dated October 30, 1957, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, subject to said note and mortgage, which are hereinafter called the "Obligation," and

WHEREAS, in the aforesaid deed the Obligor assumed the balance due on the aforesaid mortgage and said Obligor has requested Carolina to extend the time for the performance of the Obligation.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements hereinafter expressed:

1. Carolina agrees to extend the time of payment of \$17,598.92 now remaining unpaid under the Obligation so that it shall be payable as follows: \$121.08 on the 1st day of November, 1957, and a like payment of \$121.08 upon the first day of each month thereafter until paid in full and, if not sooner paid, the balance on October 1, 1977, said
