Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the South side of Glassy Mtg. road, adjoining lands of John Emery, and tract of land conveyed to Ora Turner by Callie Pittman, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mtg. of Glassy Mtn. Township 1929 and having the following distances and courses to wit.

BEGINNING at iron pin on east bank of creck, stone gone. John Emery corner, runs thence N-62-15 E. 396 feet to a stone, John Emery's corner; thence N. 2-45 E. 457.5 feet to iron pin in the Glassy Mtn.
