ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina being about five miles southeast from the Greenville Court House near the White Horse Road, and being a portion of Tract No. 11 of a subdivision of 357.13 acres, more or less, devised to M. D. Earle by Elias Earle, said portion having the following metes and bounds according to the February, 1914 survey and plat of the subdivision made by R. E. Dalton:
