NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville , State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as the major portion of Lot 27 on plat of property of Wildair Estates recorded in Plat Book EE, Page 19, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and having according to a more recent survey by R. W. Dalton dated April 4, 1958, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Sheraton Avenue at the corner of Lot 33 and 27 and running thence with Sheraton Avenue S.76-20 W. 190 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Sheraton Avenue and Burgundy Drive, the chord of which is N. 59-30 W. 36.2 feet to an iron pin on Burgundy Drive; thence with said Burgundy Drive N. 15-19 W. 96.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 12-10 W. 95 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 10-37 W. 91.4 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly of Burch N. 83-48 E. 226.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 32 and Lot 33 S. 10-33 E. 280.36 feet to the point of beginning.
