"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Highland Township, lying on the east side of the Old Ballenger Mill Road now a new state highway which leads from the old Wilson place at Highland to State Highway 11, bounded on the north and northwest by lands of Bertha Bates Slatton and J.A. Howard, on the east by M.A. Hall, on the south by Nancy W. Finley, and on the west by Wilson Roe and land this day conveyed to Mr. and Mrs. O.L.
