, "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Highland Township, lying on the west side of the Old Ballenger Mill Road, now a new state highway which leads from the Wilson place at Highland to State Highlany No. 11, bounded on the north and northwest by Bertha Bates Slatton, on the east by Wilson Roe and lands of B.W. Turpin, on the south and west by Ed Howard, and having the following courses and distances:
