with interest thereon from date at the rate of repaid:

per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be

\$70.00 on June 15,1958, and a like payment of \$70.00 on the 15thday of each month thereafter until five years after date at which time the unpaid balance will be due and payable, with interest thereon from date at the rate of five and one half per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid monthly

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, at the corner of Grove Road and Edgewood Drive (formerly Owens Street), shown as lot 9, on plat designated as Langley Heights, recorded in Plat Book I at Pages 142 and 143, made by Dalton & Neves, in June 1937, and more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of Grove Road and Edgewood Drive (formerly Owens Street) and running thence S. 79-52 W. along Grove Road 100 feet to an iron pin, thence continuing along Grove Road, S. 72-18 W. 122.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 40-13 W. 20 feet to an iron pin joint corner of lots 8 and 9; thence along joint line of lots 8 and 9, N. 49-47 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on Edgewood Drive (formerly Owens Street); thence with said Drive, S. 40-13 E. 117 feet to the beginning corner."
