Highway No. 29, and being shown as lots ONE (1), TWO (2), THREE (3), FOUR (4), FIVE (5), SIX (6), SEVEN (7), EIGHT (8), NINE (9), TEN (10), ELEVEN (11), TWELVE (12), THIRTEEN (13) and FOURTEEN (14) on a plat made foe A. S. Bass and C. A. Groce by H. L. Dunahoo, surveyor, dated June 23, 1947 and a true copy made April 23, 1958, recorded in plat book KK page 147, Greenville County R. M. C.
