McWilliams and on the West by lands of Mrs. Lessie M. Vaughn, and being all of the property on a plat made for Thomas Dewey Vaughn by H. S. Brockman surveyor, dated November 28, 1955, plat recorded in Greenville County R.M.C. Office, and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat.
