

BEGINNING on a stake in Vaughn's Creek, running thence North 29 West 630 of a point on the branch; thence North 822 West 250 to a point on the branch; thence North 53 West 9,50 to a point on said branch; thence South $77\frac{1}{2}$ West 9.30 to a point on said branch; thence South 75 West 2.35 to a point in said branch; thence South $51\frac{1}{2}$ West 71.00 to a stake; thence South 62 East 13.66 chains on a plat made by J. H. Atkins; thence North 99 East 5.50 to a stake; thence North 7 East 11.75 to a stone; thence South 30 East 5.00 to a stone; thence South 78 East 6.32 to a stone; thence South 50% East 3.50 to a stone; thence North 63 East 2.20 to the BEGINNING corner, containing 20.50 acres, more or less. Joins lands of P. D. Campbell and others. The beginning point is a large maple on the south bank of North Vaughn's Creek which is well marked and well established and well known locally as the corner of the Plumley and Lockhart land. Being the identical land conveyed to me by John P. Lockhart and Necie E. Lockhart by deed dated April 7, 1941, recorded in Book 235 at ||Pare 344.
