"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Southwest side of the Parker Road (formerly known as Morgan Road) and on the North side of Morgan Street, in the section known as City View, near the City of Greenville, being known as Lot 33, and a portion of Lot 33 A, on a plat of Morgan Hill addition, made May 15, 1902, recorded in Plat Book A at page 69, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Morgan Street, said pin being 218 feet west from the Northwest corner of the intersection of Morgan Street, and Parker Road, and running thence along the North side of Morgan Street, S. 82-3/4 W. 25 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 7-1/4 W. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of lot 33 B, N. 82-3/4 E. 174 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Parker Road; thence along the Southwest side of Parker Road, S. 37 W. 74 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot 33 A; thence with the line of Lot 33 A, S. 82-3/4 W. 184 feet to an iron pin; thence across let 33A, S. 7-1/4 E. 60 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Morgan Street; the point of beginning.
