NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

just outside the City of Greenville, and according to a survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service, in July 1958 is described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Deering Street, corner of Southern Railroad Spur Track, running thence with the southern side of Deering Street, S. 87-11 W. 109.7 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of an 8 foot drainage easement; thence along the eastern side of said easement S. 2-26 E. 150.5 feet to iron pin; thence N. 88-41 E. 145.1 feet along the line of lots 138 and 139 to an iron pin on the western side of said spur track; thence along the western side of said spur track N. 15-22 W. 158.1 feet to the beginning corner.
