before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, O'Neal Township, about one half mile West from Berry's Mill, lying on the northern side of the Berry's Mill-O'Neal Road, being bounded on the North by other lands of C. O. Berry on the East by lands of Earnest Brown, on the South by the said road and lands of Mrs. Florence Holtzclaw, and on the West by lands of Paul Barton and Jordan, and being a part of the land known as the Mitchell Estate, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-
