All those pieces, parcels or lots of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as all of Lots 41, 42, and 43 and a portion of Lots 40, 8 and 9, Block B, as shown on Map of Norwood Heights, plat of which is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, page 217, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
