Childers, Jr., his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 18 of a subdivision known as North Garden according to a plat thereof prepared by Woodward Engineering Company, May, 1954, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE, page 63, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
